

## Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. All contestants must submit and pass a psychological stress evaluation test when requested
2. ENTRY FEE is \$170.00 per club. A late fee of \$60.00 will be assessed after April 15 2008.
3. Only clubs that are affiliated and in good standing with the Association of Louisiana Bass Clubs are eligible to compete.
4. All fish must be taken with rod and reel on artificial lures, trolling will not be permitted. All Local, state and federal laws must be obeyed. If a club is ruled disqualified by the Tournament Committee their name will be pulled from the boat drawing.
5. Each club will fish with its own members (3) three boats per club, (2) men to each boat. Each Team is to appoint a captain to be their spokesman. **TEAM CAPTAIN MUST** check with Tournament Committee between 4:00 P.M. and 8:00 P.M. on Friday April 25, 2008. The Committee will be at the pavilion at San Miguel Park.
6. Only (12) twelve bass per team per day, measuring (14) inches or more. Mouth must be closed and tail touching. A Golden Rule is the official measuring board. There will be a .50 dead fish penalty for each fish brought to the scales. **NO COURTESY MEASUREMENTS AT SCALES.**
7. Total cumulative weight for the two days will determine the winning club. In the event of a tie, the largest bass on the second day will determine the winner. If still a tie, it will be broken by a flip of a coin.
8. All bass weighed dead will go to charity, except trophy fish.
9. The Tournament will begin at 6:30 A.M. unless otherwise stated at time of check in or at the end of the first days weigh in as determined by the tournament committee. There will be two flights at check in, one at 3:30 P.M. and one at 4:00 P.M. on Saturday. There will be one at 1:30 P.M. and 2:00 P.M. on Sunday. There will be check ins at the top of the hill and at the Marina. No grace period will be allowed.
10. No contestant is allowed to fish within 50 Yards of a competing boat that is tied or anchored unless permission has been granted.
11. All boats must have operating running lights and an operating kill switch that is attached to the Driver's life jacket.
12. All contestants must wear Coast Guard approved life vests when the big engine is running.
13. Alcoholic beverages or narcotic drugs will not be allowed in boats during tournament hours, unless prescribed by a doctor .
14. Only Best Six contestants are allowed on the lake for bass fishing. Other club members are allowed on the lake during tournament hours for any purpose other than bass fishing. The lake will be **off limits** from 4:00P.M. Saturday until safe blast off on Sunday.
15. **NO WAKE ZONE** There positively will be no boats plowing wakes in marina area. No wake area will be marked.
16. Interpretation and enforcement of all rules will be the sole responsibility of the Tournament Committee. Any situation not covered by the above rules and regulations will be determined by the Tournament Committee, and their decision will be final. Any protest must be made in writing within fifteen(15) minutes of the last weigh-in of that day.
17. At the time of the drawing for the boat, the winning club will furnish a name and social security number for the 2008 IRS purposes to the A.L.B.C. If unable to furnish this information, the club will forfeit the drawing.
18. **Proof of Boat Liability Insurance for all boats in the tournament must be submitted with entry. Proof must show Boat identification, amount of liability and policy coverage dates.**
